NEW MODELS

ANNOUNCED JULY 14th, 1937

The Big Seven—This entirely new model supplements the Austin range as an enlarged version of the famous Austin Seven. It has a 4-door saloon body, a new chassis and power unit, with "live" rubber engine mountings, low periodicity springing and full Girling brakes. The bodywork is particularly generously equipped with large-dial instruments and a rear panel that encloses the spare wheel or serves as a luggage platform. The specification also includes compensated voltage control and the new engine, which has inclined valves and a three-bearing counterbalanced crankshaft, develops 25 b.h.p. at 4,000 r.p.m., although only rated at 7.992 h.p.

The Eighteen—The new Austin Eighteen Windsor saloon provides exceptionally generous accommodation for seven persons. Features of the new bodywork are the wide doors, the flat floor unobstructed either by controls, transmission tunnel, or footwells, the luxurious equipment including provision for adjustment of all the seats, and footrests and folding tables for the rear passengers. The sliding roof is flush fitting and the body is sound insulated throughout. Notable new chassis features are the "live" rubber engine mountings, twopiece propeller shaft with rubber mounted bearing in the frame cross bracing, and the low periodicity springs with provision for lubrication by oil.
